## Still Time To Plant!

We're often asked if it's okay to plant this late in the year - in fact many customers think that the <u>only</u> time to plant anything is on Victoria Day weekend! Here's the scoop: annuals shouldn't be planted before the May long weekend as there is still a danger of frost that will kill them. But perennials, trees and shrubs can be planted as long as you can dig in the ground - from early spring right up until late fall...just be sure to keep everything well watered, no matter what time of year you're planting.

So, this is a great time to shop for plants to fill in those empty spots in your garden. We have all of our nursery stock on sale for at least 25% off, and there's a good chance that we'll increase the discount if you buy lots or smile at us nicely! We still have some amazing trees and shrubs in stock, various beeches, Japanese maples, hydrangeas, dogwoods, exotic looking evergreens, and lots of perennials for sun and shade. Stop in any time August 28 to October 20.
